



## 2016 Reining Class Rules and Descriptions

CRHA is an affiliate of NRHA. CRHA follows and enforces all NRHA Rules unless otherwise stated.

Class	Description
Ladies / Gents	Open to any rider Non Pro OR Open. Open to any horse. Following AQHA equipment rules only. <b>Riders may use a horse without the restrictions of ownership. . No Year End Award is available for Ladies/Gents Classes.</b>
Youth 13 and Under	Open to any Youth rider who is age 13 or under on January 1 of the current year. Riders must use horses with ownership as defined in the NRHA Youth Show Rules and Regulations.
Youth 14-18	Open to any Youth rider who is age 14 to 18 on January 1 of the current year. Riders must use horses with ownership as defined in the NRHA Youth Show Rules and Regulations.
Green as Grass	Open to Non Pro or Youth riders who are beginning reiners who are in their first or second consecutive year of showing. Riders in this class cannot have earned more that \$100 lifetime in any reining competition, nor can they have won a yearend award from any organization for reining. Yearend Green as Grass Champion and Reserve Champion are no longer eligible in succeeding years. Riders may use a horse without the restrictions of ownership. <b>NEW RULE: Rider may use one or two hands in any LEGAL bridle. Must not change or switch from one to two hands. Start one handed, stay one handed. Start two handed, stay two handed.</b>
Rookie Level 1	Open to any rider who has earned less than <b>\$500</b> in lifetime earnings in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, 9 and 10 or fifty ( <b>100</b> ) youth points (excluding points earned in the Youth 10 & Under Short Stirrup class, CRHA GAG & CRHA Youth.). Riders may use a horse without the restrictions of ownership.
Rookie Level 2	Open to any rider who has earned less than <b>\$1500</b> in lifetime earnings in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, 9 and 10 or one hundred ( <b>200</b> ) youth points (excluding points earned in the Youth 10 & Under Short Stirrup class, CRHA GAG & CRHA Youth earnings). Riders may use a horse without the restrictions of ownership.
Prime Time Rookie	Open to any rider who is 50 or older as of January 1.
Non Pro	Open to any non pro rider as defined in the Non Pro section of the <i>NRHA Handbook</i> .
Limited Non Pro	Open to any non pro rider who has earned less than \$4,500 in all NRHA Categories except 3, 7, 9 and 10 over the three previous calendar years.
Intermediate Non Pro	Open to and non pro rider who has earned less than \$15,000 in all NRHA Categories except 3, 7, 9 and 10 over the previous three calendar years.
Prime Time Non Pro	Subject to the general NRHA conditions and rules.
Novice Horse Non Pro L2	Subject to the general conditions but restricted to horses that have not earned more than \$25,000 in lifetime earnings in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, 9 and 10.
Novice Horse Open L2	Subject to the general conditions but restricted to horses that have not earned more than \$25,000 in lifetime earnings in all NRHA categories except 3, 7, 9 and 10. Not eligible for CRHA Reiner of the Year.
Open	Subject to the general conditions, any rider may show any horse in this class. Not eligible for CRHA Reiner of the Year.
LTD Open	Subject to the general NRHA conditions. Not eligible for CRHA Reiner of the Year
