

The Challenge

Terms and Conditions for the CRHA Amateur Division Futurity & Derby

- 1. The class is to be held concurrently with the NRHA Non Pro Derby and NRHA Non Pro Futurity held during the California Reining Horse Challenge.**
- 2. The rider may not have earned more than \$25,000 lifetime in NRHA, NCHA, AQHA, or NRCHA or any other breed or discipline association at the start of the class.**
- 3. The rider may not have ever received any kind of remuneration in their life for riding, training, or teaching another person to ride directly or indirectly.**
- 4. The rider may not have any immediate family or household member who is a horse trainer/professional or has been a trainer/professional within the last five years. Immediate family is defined as a parent, guardian, grandparent, sibling, fiancé, husband, wife, boyfriend/girlfriend (person with whom rider co-habitates), and/or child.**
- 5. Show Management reserves the right to determine rider's eligibility in the event there are eligibility disputes or questions. All decisions are final.**
- 6. Rider must be a current CRHA member.**
